What an amazing Fall Festival: fun for families and a successful silent auction!

We are SO GRATEFUL to all the volunteers who made the Fall Festival possible - the members of our Fall Fest Committee, caregivers who donated their time for set-up and clean-up, donated cakes for the Cake Walk, items for classroom baskets and candy for trick-or-treating...the PTA is so impressed with all your support. Thanks to all who attended the Festival!

The PTA Silent Auction was our best yet! We raised over \$8500.

A huge thank you to our Silent Auction Committee which spent many weeks rounding up donations for the event. It's our biggest fundraiser of the year, and makes so much PTA programming possible. If you won an item and still need to pick it up, please contact us at belmarptainfo@gmail.com.

Your donations to our fundraising efforts pay for many things, including TEACHER GRANTS. Twice a year, the PTA approves special one-time grants for items to help students that don't fit into the school's regular budget. In October, the PTA Teacher Grants Committee approved the following teacher grant requests:

Ms. Burnett: 6 picture books focusing on music: \$95

Ms, Stimak: Light/glare covers for the overhead lights in her classroom to add a calming effect: \$86

Ms. Knickelbein: Stickers for her prize bin, graphic novels and picture books that pair with new Wit and Wisdom

curriculum: \$100

Ms. Knickelbein and Ms. Allen also requested headphones as part of their grant. PTA will be purchasing 130 higher quality sets of headphones for the school.

Mr. Fisher, Ms. Finholm, and Ms. Lillard will be receiving grant requests through the school funding available for SSN/SPED resources.

PTA loves being able to support our student's classroom experiences!

Arts Integration

BelArts receives coaching from teaching artists through the REACH grant and PTA is able to support these efforts even more with a portion of the Arts Integration budget! This November PTA will contribute toward bringing one of these artists to work with staff and students AND put on a school-wide assembly demonstrating all of the incredible skills attained from this coaching!

Community Support

The PTA budget values our community needs and will be purchasing a cabinet to store non-perishable food items being received from Jeffco Eats, https://jeffcoeats.org/. This will become the BelArts emergency food bank and will be available to families that wish to receive food items!
